Liz won the award for Best Supporting Actress at The Irish Times Theatre Awards 2019 for her performance in The Abbey & Complex co-production DUBLIN WILL SHOW YOU HOW by Tracy Martin.

In 2021 Liz appeared in the first live show after lockdown at The Abbey Theatre ONE GOOD TURN by Una McKeivitt playing the role of Fiona and directed by Emma Jordan. Liz also starred on television playing the role of Nicola alongside Domhnall Gleeson and Brian Gleeson in black comedy FRANK OF IRELAND for Channel 4 and Merman.

Recent screen credits include the BBC/Hulu smash hit NORMAL PEOPLE directed by Lenny Abrahamson and Hettie Macdonald, feature HERSELF directed by Phyllida Lloyd, TV Series THE SOUTH WESTERLIES for Deadpan Pictures playing opposite Eileen Walsh and short film CALVINGS directed by Louis Bhoose for Agile Films.

On stage she recently appeared as Lady Macbeth in an Irish Language version of MACBETH (MAC AN BHEATHA) for Fíbin Theatre Company. She recently performed her one-woman show KICKING ALL THE BOXES at the Vaults Festival in London. Other recent credits include the role of Patricia in Philip Doherty's REDEMPTION OF A ROGUE, Vicky in John Andrew O'Rourke's short film LITTLE DEVIL, TORAÍOCHT directed by Mikel Murfi, and REMEMBER TO BREATHE directed by Orla Murphy. Liz is also a well-established and versatile voiceover artist and most recently recorded INTERVIEW WITH A GENERAL written by Peter Sirr and directed by Aidan Mathews for RTÉ Radio Drama on One. Liz trained at the Gaiety School of Acting.
